Safety Regulations

Please help us make your stay at Camp Lee as safe and enjoyable as possible by making your group aware of these safety rules:

- 1. Notify the camp staff concerning: Medical emergencies (first aid is always available), Maintenance problems, Emergency Situations, Suspicious persons in camp who may be trespassing.
- 2. Camp Lee does not allow any of the following:
 - Drugs or alcohol
 - Ground fires
 - Smoking in buildings
 - Fireworks
 - Firearms or weapons
 - Candles in cabins
 - Pets or animals
 - Flammable liquids or poisonous substances
 - No personal sports equipment
- 3. Limit your activities to your groups' assigned area.
- 4. Familiarize your group with all fire exits in the buildings you are using.
- 5. Do not allow children to go to the creek, lakes, or hiking without an adult. Everyone should have a buddy.
- 6. Do not tamper with the fire extinguishers. They are for emergency use only.
- 7. Walk--no vehicles are allowed in camp. The speed limit for the entry road is 15 MPH
- 8. Park only in designated areas. Don't block the roads.
- 9. Obey the lifeguards at the pool, lake, Water Zip Line, and Rock Slide—they are here for your safety. Adult leaders should support all lifeguards and program staff in rule enforcement.
- 10. Wear shoes always. Shoes are mandatory in the Dining Hall.
- 11. Avoid direct contact with wildlife.
- 12. No one is allowed on the activity equipment without an instructor.
- 13. No one is allowed at the Rock Slide without a camp lifeguard.
- 14. When hiking, stay on marked trails.
- 15. Do not pick or cut flowers, shrubs or trees.
- 16. Do not walk on the dam at the Upper Lake.
- 17. Passengers are not allowed in truck beds.
- 18. Sleeping Quarter Ratios: There must be two adult chaperones present in sleeping quarters when campers are present.

Camp Lee Emergency Procedures

In case of fire: Remove your group from the affected area to a safe location and as far removed from fire as possible.

In case of severe weather: Move your group to Genesis Lodge or the nearest unaffected shelter.

IN ANY EMERGENCY SITUATION, PLEASE ACCOUNT FOR ALL MEMBERS OF YOUR GROUP AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND CONTACT THE CAMP DIRECTOR.

IN CASE OF LOST CAMPER, PLEASE NOTIFY THE CAMP DIRECTOR.
